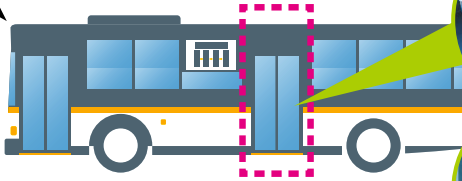

How to Pay Fare

Cash Payment (Boarding Ticket)

1 Please board from the middle door.



Please take a boarding ticket from the dispenser at the entrance. This ticket will be needed when you exit the bus.



2 When your destination is announced, press the stop button.



On board the bus, an announcement advises you of the next stop.

The name of the next stop is displayed on the board at the front of the bus.

Stop button shape may vary depending on bus.

3 The fare board shows fares by boarding ticket number.



Boarding Ticket Number

Fare

Look for the number of your boarding ticket (received when boarding the bus) to find your fare.

The boarding ticket number varies depending on bus stop. Please be certain to take a ticket when boarding the bus.

* Adult fares are shown. Child fares (under 12 years) are half price.

4 Please pay your fare when you exit the bus.

The exit is at the front of the bus. Please deposit your fare, together with your boarding ticket, into the fare box located next to the driver.



Fare boxes do not provide change. If you require change, please insert a 1,000 yen note into the change machine located next to the driver. Change will be dispensed in coins. * Please note that 5,000 yen and 10,000 yen notes cannot be changed.

Priority Seats



Seats marked with this symbol are priority seats. Please give up these seats to elderly passengers, passengers with special needs, unwell passengers, pregnant passengers, and passengers with small children (including passengers with baby strollers.)

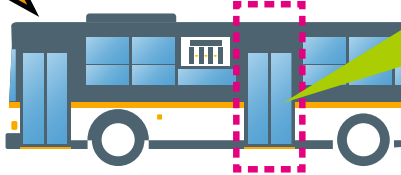
How to Pay Fares

IC Card Payment * IC Cards can be purchased at ticket vending machines.

1 Please board from the middle door.

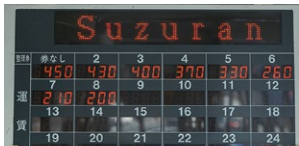


Touch your card to the IC card reader located at the bus entrance.



- * Throughout Hokkaido, the entrance location may vary depending on bus type.
- * Accepted IC card types may vary by region.
- * **Some buses do not accept IC cards.**

3 The next bus stop is displayed on the sign at the front of the bus.



2 When your destination is announced, press the stop button.

On board the bus, an announcement advises you of the next stop. Once the bus has come to a stop, please make your way to the exit at the front of the bus.



Stop button shape may vary depending on bus.

4 Touch your card to the IC card reader.



Fare is displayed on screen.



◀ Touch your card to the IC card reader located next to the driver, and exit the bus.

* If your IC card does not have sufficient balance for the bus fare, please pay the shortfall in cash. Alternatively, please inquire with the driver to recharge your IC card, and touch the reader again to pay the shortfall.

* IC cards may be charged in 1,000 yen increments. (Maximum 10,000 yen)

How to Pay Fares

For Advance Purchase Tickets (Airport Bus)

1 Purchasing Tickets at the Airport Counter



For example, if taking a bus from New Chitose Airport, bus tickets may be purchased in advance at the New Chitose Airport counter, or from vending machines.

* Fare may also be paid in cash or by IC card when exiting the bus.

- * At airports other than New Chitose Airport, tickets can similarly be purchased from vending machines.
- * At New Chitose Airport, round-trip tickets may also be purchased.
- * If taking a bus to New Chitose Airport, purchase your ticket at the bus terminal counter.
- * Please note that some airport buses do not accept onboard cash or IC card payments.
- * In addition to airport bus tickets, there are other types of pre-purchasable tickets.

3 An announcement advises you of the next stop.

When your destination stop is announced, press the nearest stop button.



The name of the next stop is displayed ▶ on the board at the front of the bus.



Some airport buses are nonstop service to the final destination only.

2 Please board the bus at the front.



◀ Please leave any luggage with the staff before boarding.

Some types of airport buses have boarding doors in the middle.

4 Please place your purchased ticket into the fare box.

For cash payments, ▶ the fare is displayed on the board at the front of the bus.



- * Fare boxes do not provide change. If you require change, please insert a 1,000 yen note into the change machine located next to the driver. Change will be dispensed in coins.
- * Please note that 5,000 yen and 10,000 yen notes cannot be changed.
- * Insert banknotes into the same machine as the change dispenser. Place coins into the fare box.
- * To pay by IC card, touch your card to the reader located next to the driver's seat.
- * If your IC card does not have sufficient balance for the bus fare, please pay the shortfall in cash. Alternatively, please inquire with the driver to recharge your IC card, and touch the reader again to pay the shortfall.
- * IC cards may be charged in 1,000 yen increments. (Maximum 10,000 yen)
